

Show Table Guidelines

The show table is an opportunity for a club to show off woodworking skills within their own ranks. It is also an opportunity for individuals to be entered into the “Best Individual Piece” category.

Each club will be given a table measuring 2400 X 600 on which ten items made by club members can be displayed. Dressing the table in a manner that will best enhance the items displayed is the responsibility of each club. Club banners or other identification is encouraged and does not count as one of the ten items. Points will be awarded by the judges for:

- Layout
- Lighting – a power point will be provided
- Eye appeal – the “wow factor”
- Colour
- Table cover
- Club identification

One item only per woodworker.

A piece that has won a prize at an earlier Fun Day cannot be entered.

There is to be a minimum of six turned items, with at least two spindle and two faceplate turnings.

A maximum of four non turned items can be displayed.

All items displayed, including non turned items, are eligible for judging in the “Best Individual Piece” category.

Items displayed are to have the name of the woodworker covered and each item is to be numbered.

Clubs are to provide one judge to judge “best table”. Judges will not judge their own Club’s table.

The winning club will be awarded \$150.

Best Individual Pieces will be awarded \$100 for being first, \$75 for second and \$25 for third.
