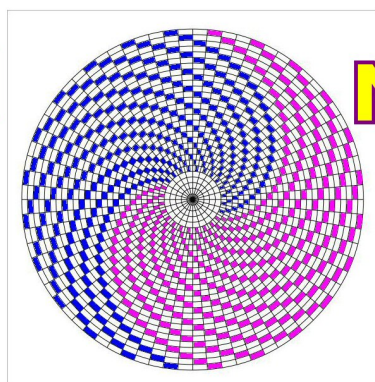

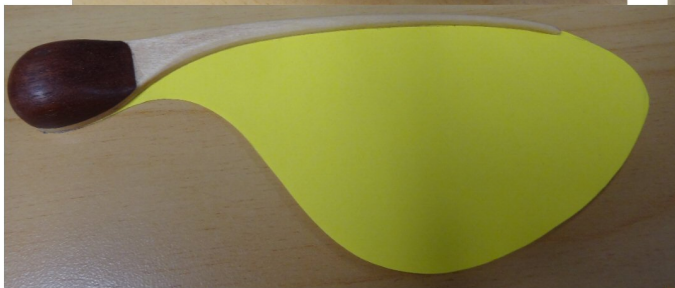
Thread cutting in wood by Peter Clemett (June Demo)

Peter talked about the selection of timber being very important to achieve a good finish of the thread, the number of threads whether coarse or fine being critical also. Peter showed us some thread cutting tools that he was using and also some slides of other cutting dies and taps that are available. Two demonstration pieces had been prepared, sections of blue acrylic had been glued to wood to be a bolt and a nut. The nut blank was held in the chuck and using the chasing cutter of twenty threads per inch, Peter proceeded to cut the internal thread using a sort of rectangular motion, gradually turning the thread down to the full depth. The bolt blank was then mounted in the chuck and the blank trimmed down to the outside diameter of the nut thread. With the chasing cutter set at the centre height, the thread was slowly cut down to the full depth. The previously cut nut was then tried and after a bit of careful trimming, a good fit was achieved. concluding another successful demonstration. Rick Bolch (scribe)

The class will be making a lidded box with inlay.

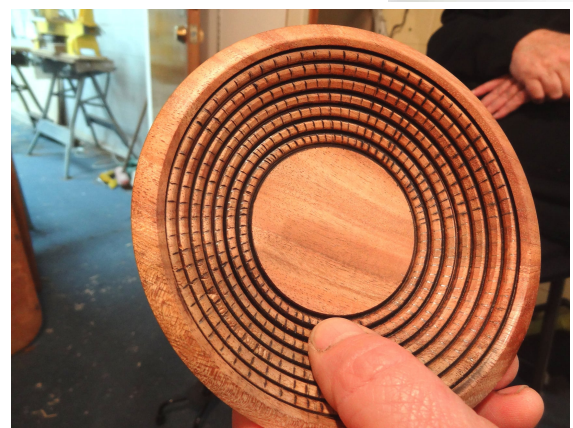
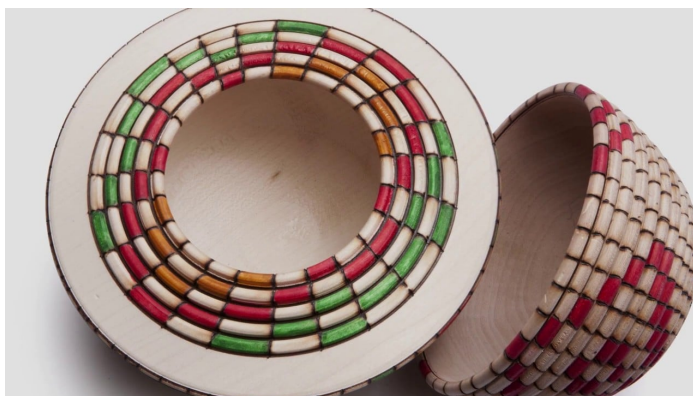
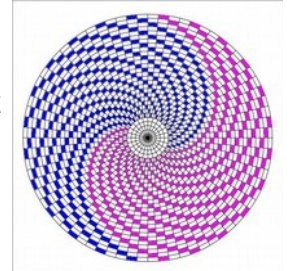
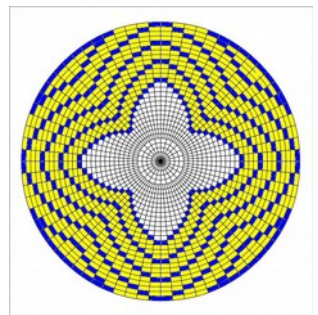
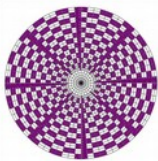
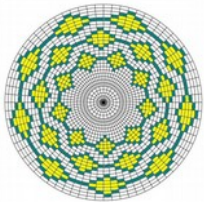

Basket Weave Illusion Group

We have put together a temporary group of people interested in exploring the basket weave illusion technique. This involves beading a bowl or box, dividing the circular beads up into segments and colouring the segments. On the first session we had a look at beading tools and for the second session we set up an indexing jig for marking up the beads into segments. The segments are defined by pyrography or branding. Over the next three weeks we will be having a play with patterns and colouring the segments. We will have a final session on spraying the finished pieces with aerosol lacquer to fix and protect the colour. We will do this on a fine Saturday afternoon so that we can spray outside. (probably August 22nd at 1pm if it is fine) I'll let members of the group know closer to the time.

The beading tools, indexing jig, pyrography tips and Tombow coloured pens are available at the workshop on Thursdays and open workshop Saturdays.
