Marbling demonstration with Dick Veitch

Dick began with a history of paints.

Acrylic paint is used for marbling.

Finish the wood to 400 grit

Wet with alum

Aluminium Potassium Sulphate

Always plan

Use scribing block to mark straight line, otherwise may not be steady.

Use yellow or blue masking tape to define area to be marbled

Use distilled water in a basin

Squirt dark colour first on surface of water

Use 4 colours twice

Dip bowls flat surface onto paint surface then wash under running water.

Remove residual paint from surface of the water with paper towel.

Add new colours to surface.

Repeat with wooded piece

Refresh the paint on the water.

Dipped shawl buckle, added white to dip Christmas tree ball then wash again.

Use rectangular tray added 5 colours, raked surface placed in wooden cylinder segment.


Mounted wooded cylinder in chuck, masked with blue tape.

Set up air spray and pump compressor sprayed cylinder black while rotating chuck by hand.

After paint dried, removed the blue tape.



Zoom meetings past and into the future


