COVID Traffic lights and ourselves at Orange

As you have already been advised, entry to our workshop at Auburn Reserve will require that you produce your vaccine pass. These will be scanned before entry is allowed.

The Christchurch City Council has now imposed conditions relating to the hiring of the Harvard Lounge, venue for our monthly meeting at Wigram. If we choose to operate as a vaccine pass required activity, we would not have to pay for additional high touch cleans to be carried out by Council's service provider after each meeting. We are required to ensure surfaces and touch points are washed / sanitized before sessions and provide hand sanitizer or equivalent for participants and guests.

Consequent to the above, meetings at the Harvard Lounge with effect from our meeting on the 26th January will require that you produce your vaccine pass. These will be scanned before entry is allowed.

At Orange level, the wearing of masks is also encouraged.
