
Change of venue for the March and April meetings Fendalton Community Hall

Yarn bowl demonstrations

The demonstrations focussed on different methods to cut out the side of a bowl to accommodate the feeding of wool to a knitter whilst retaining the ball of wool inside the bowl.

Keith McFadden start off the demonstrations with his bowl held in a Woodcut Pro Mount jig that was in turn held in the lathe banjo. After drawing the pattern onto the bowl, Keith used a coping saw with a fine blade to cut out the required shape.





Noel Graham used a different system attached to the lathe bed for holding the bowl. His cutting tool of choice was a jigsaw fitted with a fine woodcutting blade. Noel made the point that the jigsaw base had to be held firmly against the side of the bowl to avoid the blade jumping and possibly damaging the bowl.

Peter Clemett took a different path from the previous to demonstrators by carving the cut out using a flexi shaft pendant drive similar to this <u>Axminster Tools system</u>.

The bowl was held in the Pro Mount jig and progressively carved until the required shape was cut right through. The same flexi shaft tool could also be used with sanding attachments to complete the process, blending in the cut out shape.
