Angel, Four-Axis: Turning Sequence Part 2

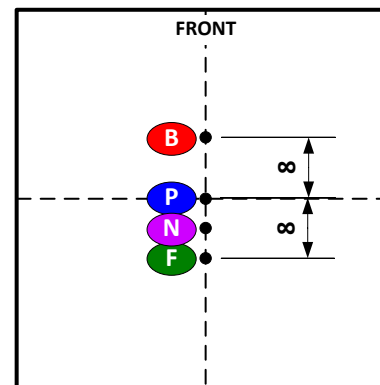

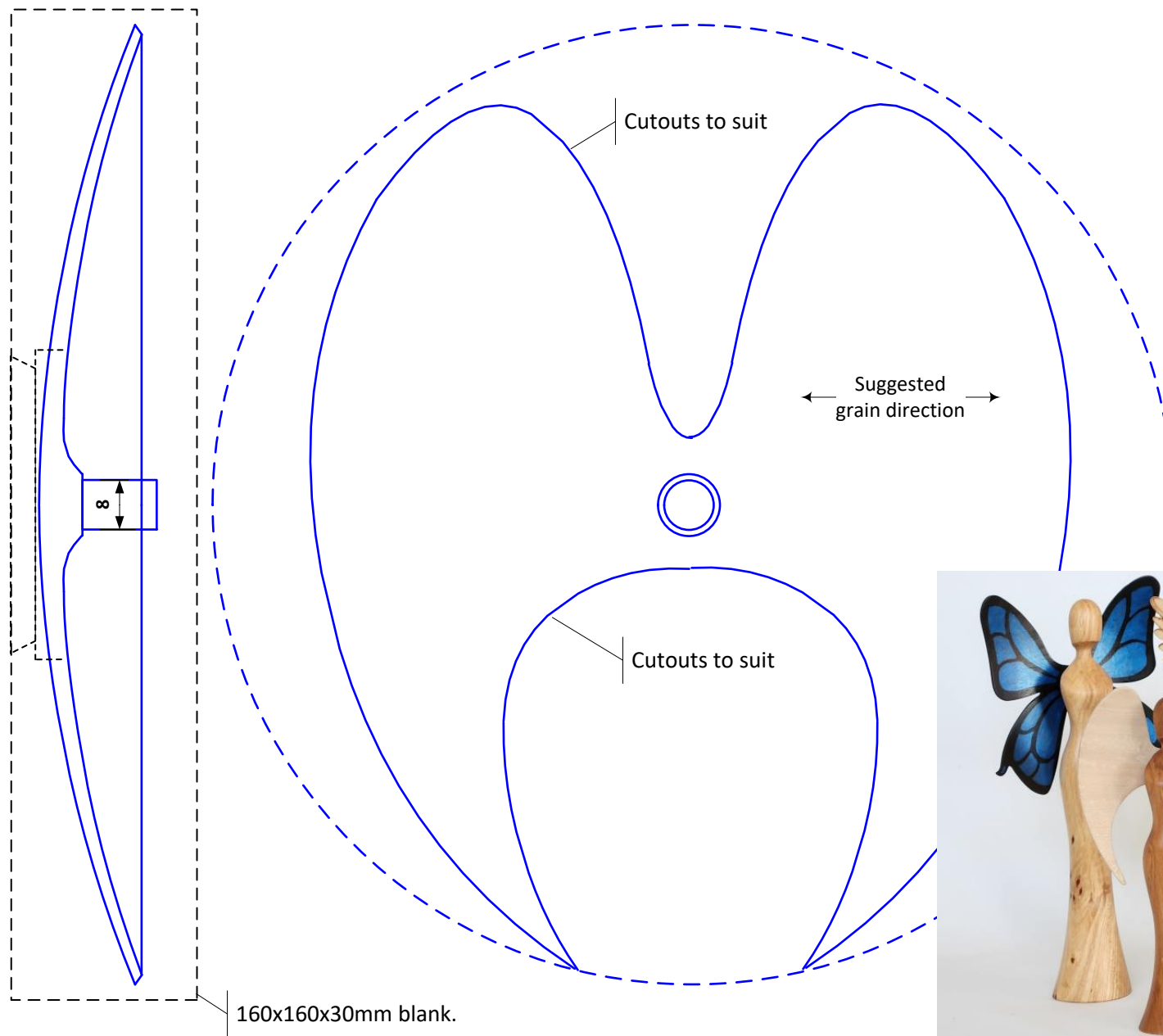

For wider or taller wing profiles, you could start with a rectangular blank to save wood.

If not colouring the wings, use a timber which contrasts with the torso.
